

General Information:

Rain Forest Research Institute is an independent institute under the administrative control of ICFRE, Dehradun and is situated in Jorhat district of state of Assam at Sotai. The institute is functioning in a campus which is around 28 hectares in where various offices, laboratories, auditorium, community center, scientists' hostel, farmers' hostel and around 50 residential quarters are located. Around 170 employees including workers are attending daily in the institute and around 100 family members are staying in the campus. The institute is having two water distribution systems called, **Single Vessel Iron removing plant**, installed by the CPWD. The underground water is collected, treated, stored and distributed to all the places of works and quarters. The potable water was chemically analyzed and found that it contains certain impurities apart from high TDS which are harmful for human use and sometimes not fit for laboratory use also. The institute is managing both the systems with the technical knowhow and manpower available with us at present.

Scope of work:

The institute requires quality potable water for all purposes from these two systems. Therefore, the institute invites EOI from the qualified firms having experience in this field for submitting a **detail execution plan** for continuous supply of quality potable water from the existing systems **with diagram**, items and quantity of chemicals required, calculation of optimum quantity of water required for consumption per day and all other specifications with details. The firms interested to submit EOI may visit both the systems and for this they may contact Estate Officer, RFRI during any working day from 10am to 4pm.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria for submission of EOI:

1. Firm must be an Institutional company or contractor in the sector.
2. Firm must possess valid CST/Sate VAT/TIN registrations.
3. Firm must have positive working capital during last two financial years. Copy of audited financial statements (i.e. Balance sheet and Profit & Loss account) for immediately two previous financial years 2012-13 & 13-14 must be furnished as documentary evidence in support.
4. Firm must have completed at least one such work or running similar work at present. Documentary evidence to be submitted.
5. Cost of EOI document Rs. 250.00 only.

EOI should be submitted in hard copies. Short listed firms will be called for a meeting and detail discussion in the institute for finalizing the specifications etc. Based on the specifications, Request For Proposal (RFP) will be called for executing the work wherever required.

Interested Firm(s) must respond to this EOI notification latest by 1400 Hrs. IST on 28th May, 2014.


