Terms of Reference

1. The expert will facilitate and assist the project team's work in preparation of the project report for one of the three forest landscapes of India i.e, Sikkim (Eastern District), Himachal (Kullu & Rampur, Shimla Forest Divisions) and Madhya Pradesh (Harda & Hoshangabad Forest Divisions).
2. The total emoluments of the experts to complete the assignment will be Rs 1.00 lakh (One Lakh).
3. The expert will be entitled to avail Travelling, Boarding and Lodging charges as per the entitled of group A officers in the grade pay of Rs 8700 for field visits in all the landscapes.
4. The mode of payment to the expert will be as under:
 - 10 percent of the contract amount will be released at the time of signing of the agreements.
 - 30 percent of the contract amount will be released after submission of the draft report.
 - 60 percent of the contract amount will be released after submission of final report.
5. The engagement shall be purely contractual and time bound.
