The ICFRE, an Autonomous Body of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India, invites applications from the eligible officers under Central/State/Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous Bodies/Statutory organizations for filling up one post of Security Officer in the revised Pay Scale of Rs. 9,300-34,800 Plus Grade Pay of Rs. 4,600/- on deputation including short term contract, at Forest Research Institute, Dehra Dun under ICFRE.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION

1. Application with complete bio-data of the candidate should be submitted to the Secretary, Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education, P.O. New Forest, Dehra Dun-248006 (UK) together with a **Demand Draft of Rs. 200/- drawn in favour of D.D.O., ICFRE on or before 15.03.2016**. The closing date of receipt of application form officers residing in Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshdweep will be **30.03.2016**. Applications received without signature of the applicant or which are not accompanied by the prescribed fee shall be summarily rejected.
2. The Council will in no case be responsible for non-receipt of applications or any delay in receipt thereof on any account whatsoever. No application received after the prescribed last date will be entertained under any circumstances and all the late applications will be summarily rejected.
3. The application should be routed through proper channel. Photocopies of ACRs grading of the officer for the last five years while forwarding the applications of the candidates should also be attached. However, an advance copy can be submitted along with Demand Draft.
4. The deputation period would initially be for a period of three years or till superannuation whichever is earlier as per rules.
5. The Council reserved the right to relax the qualification/experience in case of exceptionally qualified and meritorious candidates.
6. The council reserves the right not to fill up the vacancy advertised if the circumstances so warrant.
