TRAINING CUM WORKSHOP ON ESTABLISHMENT OF HERBAL HOME GARDENS AND TRADITIONAL HEALTH CARE AT FRCLE, AGARTALA FROM 04.01.2022 TO 05.01.2022

The training will be imparted by 4 eminent persons from Vaidyaraj Herbal Growers Society, Netaji Nagar, Kanchanpur. An Herbal home garden also established at FRCLE campus with 35 collected medicinal plants. The valedictory session was conducted on 05 January, 2023.
