ICFRE-Bamboo and Rattan Centre (ICFRE-BRC), Bethlehem Vengthlang, Aizawl, Mizoram organized a three days skill development training under Van Vigyan Kendra, Mizoram on bamboo & rattan handicrafts, from 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2024. The target group of this training were the local people of Bethlehem Vengthlang and Armed Veng.
