Significant Research Finding

ICFRE- Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

In Meghalaya, exploration of the vegetation in the forest areas of Jorabat, Byrnihat, Nongkhrah, and Umiam and the forest areas of East Khasi Hills namely, Lalitlyngkot, Maujrong, Ummdeingpoh, David Scott, Madansohum, Ladmawphlong, Laitryngew, Mawrah and Cherrapunji was carried out. The populations of five hill bamboo species namely Chimonocalamus griffithianus, Draphnostachyum falcatum, Chimnobambusa callosa (SPAR-IONG), Yushania hirsutum, and Yushania species were identified (STAW-STEM), and other exotic like Phyllostachys manii were also identified(SPAR-STEM). In addition, the associated tree species, namely Myrica esculenta, Pinus kasia, Pinus patula, Alnus nepalensis, Crptomeria japonica, and Musa sp were also noted. Herbarium specimens were also prepared for bamboo species occurring in the surveyed area.

ICFRE-Institute of Forest Productivity, Ranchi

• Identified new point of occurrence of three tree species i.e. *Schima wallichii*, *Aphanamixis polystachya* and *Toona ciliate* in West Bengal.

ICFRE- Institute of Forest Genetics & Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- *Xylia xylocarpa* an important timber species of moist deciduous forests of Western Ghats selected for domestication. Field visits were made in Tamil Nadu and Karnataka for identification of Candidate Plus Trees (CPTs) in Tamil Nadu and Karnataka. Based on the survey, identified 5 CPTs in Tamil Nadu and 10 CPTs in Karnataka for further research activities.
- Phytochemical analysis of *Canarium strictum* leaves using High Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) showed higher phenolic compounds (64.02 %) in male individuals than in the female individuals (41.88%).
- Established Germplasm of *Limonia acidissima* and *Pithecelobium dulce* in Gudular Research station, Maraimalai nagar, Chennai. Established Germplasm of *Limonia acidissima* in Kurumbapatti Research station, Salem and *Pithecellobium dulce* in Neyveli Research station, Salem.
