<u>Training-cum-awareness programme on Timber markets of</u> <u>Important Agroforestry species in Eastern U. P. in Gorakhpur</u> <u>district by CSFER, Allahabad</u>

A one-day farmers training programme on Development of Agroforestry in Eastern UP for creating awareness amongst farmers of Khadraich Gram Sabha, Pipraich block of Gorakhpur district for existing market facilities of timber of important species and tree harvesting rules of UP forest department and new market approaches for selling timber products was organized under direction of Dr. V. The farmers also discussed the practical problems in selling of timber produces and availability of quality planting material in the region.
