INAUGURATION OF COMMON FACILITY CENTER FOR BAMBOO PROCESSING AND TRAINING (CFCBPT), FOREST RESEARCH INSTITUTE, DEHRADUN

Services of the CFC will be available to stake holders at nominal fees. The CFC will also contribute towards the Division's R&D programmes on value addition in bamboo products. Many machines for cross cutting, removing nodes and skin, slicing, width slicing, stick polishing etc. have been installed at the CFC to facilitate the above objectives of the centre.
