Celebration of Van-Mahotsav-2014 by HFRI, Shimla

Himalayan Forest Research Institute, Shimla organized Van-Mahotsav on 12th August 2014 at its Campus, Panthaghati, Shimla. **Dr. V.P. He further added that the continuous decrease in forest cover at the National level was a matter of concern in the past for the Government, however, due to such initiatives/efforts, now the forest area is increasing (as per the latest reports of Forest Survey of India). The efforts made in this direction by the Government of India, State Governments, Forest Departments and other Institutions, who are working in the field of forest and environment, are really appreciable. He further added that it is a duty of every citizen to take part in such schemes/ programmes, being implemented by the Government, in the larger public interest and contribute towards sustainable development of the country.
