Workshop on Assessment of Forest Types of India

REPORT

A regional workshop on 'Assessment of Forest Types of India' was conducted in the Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding (IFGTB), Coimbatore, on 2nd February 2012. A total number of 28 experts / delegates from the State Forest Departments of Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Karnataka and research / educational organizations like Indian Institute of Science, Institute of Wood Science & Technology, Bangalore, Botanical Survey of India, Kerala Forest Research Institute, French Institute, Puducherry, Kerala Agricultural University, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirapalli, Karpagam University, Coimbatore and Calicut University, Kerala and researchers involved in Forestry from NGOs and colleges in Tamil Nadu and Kerala, participated in the workshop. The workshop was also attended by the team members of the Task Force, constituted in IFGTB for executing the works related to assessment of forest types in the mandate States.

The workshop had the following objectives:-

- To deliberate on changes happened in the vegetation of the mandate States / UTs
- To formulate methodologies for assessing the forest types

• To identify study areas, teams, collaborators and chalk out modalities / action plan
