Rain Forest Research Institute, Jorhat celebrated World Environment Day-2013 jointly with Panchawati Prakiti Mancha, an environment based NGO of Jorhat at Mahatma Gandhi College, Jorhat (Assam) on 5th June, 2013. A large section of people mainly school and college students, apart from Scientists, Officers and Supporting Staff of RFRI participated in the celebration. Various events were organized to mark the occasion.
