A Report on the Farmers' Mela under Networking of VVK with KVK, held on 19th February, 2016 organized by KVK, Ghatkhed, Amravati (Maharashtra)

Tropical Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur (M.P.) participated in the one-day training cum demonstration programme on 'Shetkari Melawa'' organized by Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Ghatkhed, Amravati (Maharashtra) on 19.02.2016 under joint venture and networking programme of Van Vigyan Kendra (VVK, TFRI, ICFRE) and Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK, ICAR).
