In this connection, the Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore, which has been in close association with the National Medicinal Plants Board organised a seedling distribution programme. The programme was organised in association with CUBE -Centre for Urban Biodiversity Conservation and Education, an organisation that creates awareness about urban biodiversity and promotes urban greenery. 
