ICFRE, Dehradun and its institutes observed Gandhi Jyanti on 2 October 2020 on the occasion also organized awareness programme on "Swachh Bharat Mission".

Significant Research Findings

Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- Santalum album L (sandalwood tree) is a semi root parasite and it requires host species to thrive. An experiment was conducted on S. album with Casuarina equisetifolia as host species along with Frankia (a symbiotic nitrogen fixing bacteria) inoculation in nursery conditions under AICRP 21 (Bio-fertilizers). After 2 month of observation, it was found that the seedlings of S. album showed improved growth (45.3 cm), stem girth (3.0 mm) and leaf numbers (26). The numbers of haustoria were also showed high (7 Nos.). The S. album seedlings along with C. equisetifolia without Frankia showed very less numbers of haustoria (2 Nos.) and less growth. It was also observed that the seedlings without host species have showed very poor performance in nursery conditions. This study explicit that S. album requires a suitable host species along with a beneficial microbe for improved growth under nursery conditions.
- The endophytic fungi isolated from important native tropical tree species of Western Ghats viz., *Tectona*

grandis, Gmelina arborea, Ailanthus excelsa, and Pterocarpus santalinus for the management of insect pests of agriculture and forestry importance having entomopathogenic significance were encapsulated using chitosan nano particle.

 Established demonstration of Gmelina based agro forestry models at Soolakal, Pollachi, Tamil Nadu. Evaluated clonal trails of *Gmelina arborea* for growth superiority and shortlisted high productive clones for establishing clonal amplification trials.

Arid Forest Research Institute, Jodhpur

 Tissue culture studies were carried on Schizostachyum dullooa. Nodal segments were used for micro-propagation. Best axillary bud break was achieved on MS medium supplemented with 5.0 mg/l BAP. After 3-4 weeks, proliferated shoots were sub cultured on fresh MS medium supplemented with cytokinin. In vitro shoot multiplication was achieved on MS medium supplemented with 2.5 mg/l BAP. It was observed that this bamboo is very recalcitrant for *in vitro* rooting.
