SIGNIFICANT RESEARCH FINDINGS

ICFRE-Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

Stability of the natural colorant derived from wild grown *Punica granatum* in milk and beverages was examined and found to be stable for use in these products.

ICFRE-Himalayan Forest Research Institute, Shimla

Mass inoculum of *Trichoderma asperellum* was successfully produced on the dropped out needles of *Pinus roxburghii*. *Trichoderma asperellum* exhibits significant antifungal properties against a variety of phytopathogens. Its cultivation on pine needles will serve two purposes: turning forest waste into biopesticide formulation and reducing the availability of pine needles for forest fires.

ICFRE-Rain Forest Research Institute(RFRI)

ICFRE- Institute of Forest Genetics & Tree Breeding, Coimbatore (IFGTB)

- MicroRNAs (miRNAs) are 21-24 nucleotides long noncoding molecules that regulate gene expression in plants. The role of miRNA in regulating the sesquiterpene biosynthesis pathway in *Santalum album* was investigated using an integrated analysis of wood transcriptome and small RNA dataset. It predicted 69 miRNA members belonging to 12 families that targeted 12 transcripts from the sesquiterpene pathway, with a maximum of 24 miRNAs regulating cytochrome P450 reductase, followed by sesquisabianene synthase 1, which was targeted by 23 miRNAs. This study provides the first crucial insight into the post-transcriptional regulation of the sesquiterpene pathway genes in the genus Santalum and opens up a new perspective in metabolite engineering for enhanced essential oil production in sandalwood.
- Molecular docking studies of the identified antiviral compounds *bufotalin, colchicine, scillarenin, phytol, a amyrin, quinine, gamma-sitosterol, lupeol, campesterol* and *stigmasterol* against the target proteins, Angiotensin Converting Enzyme -2 (ACE2), trans membrane protease serine 2 (TMPRSS2), 3C-like protease (3CLpro), papain like protease (PLpro), RNA Dependent RNA polymerase (RdRP) revealed α -amyrin as the most potential compound. It had the highest docking score of -13.4 against the protein 3CLpro and -11.8 against TMPRSS2. Stigmasterol had the strong docking scores against 4 target proteins namely ACE2, 3CLpro, PLpro and RdRP. Based on the results, it is deduced that stigmasterol could be promising lead compound for antiviral activity.
