## Significant Research Finding

#### ICFRE-Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

• DNA extraction of Trilidium was optimized and amplified with trnE-F and trnH-psbA.

- Quantitative profiling of 14 phytochemicals Ecdysone, Govanoside D, Govanoside B. Govanoside C, Clintonioside B, Helonin B, Protodioscin, Govanoside F, Pregnachacotrioside ,Pennogenin Tetraglycoside, Pennogenin Triglycoside, Pennogenin Diglycoside, Borasosi de E, and Borasoside D was conducted in Trillium govanianum rhizomes collected from Govind Pashu Vihar, Uttarkashi, Uttarakhand. Protodioscin showed the highest concentration in sample T3RBKD (32.69 mg/g), followed by Govanoside D in T2BKD(32.43 mg/g).Ecdysone and Pregnachacotrioside were consistently detected across all samples. Clintonioside B, Helonin B, and Pennogenin Diglycoside were either absent or present in trace amounts. The findings reveal notable chemotypic variation among the populations studied.
- Essential oils were extracted from various parts of *Lindera pulcherrima*, including the inflorescence ,leaves, wood, and the whole plant. The yields obtained were 0.768% from the inflorescence, 0.625% from the leaves, 0.051% from the wood, and 0.515% from the total plant material.

#### <u>ICFRE-Rain Forest Research Institute,</u> <u>Jorhat</u>

- Stored the seeds of *Bambusa bambos* at 7% moisture content under ambient condition & medium term storage (4°C and 35% RH). Seeds stored under ambient condition lost viability after 4 month.
- Developed seed leaflets of 10 economic important species of North East India for dissemination of seed technology knowledge to the various stakeholders. Seed storage behaviour was assessed for different forestry species and the seeds of 39 FGR species deposited at NBPGR New Delhi for long term seed storage.
- Vegetative propagation of *S. dullooa* through culm cuttings treated with 1000 ppm of IBA mixed with talc powder, applied directly to the

buds of the nodal region, resulted in better rooting and survival percentages. This method can be used for the large-scale cultivation of *S*. *dullooa*.

 Developed three site-specific bamboo-based windbreak model plantations by using three bamboo species namely *Thyrsostachys oliveri*, *Bambusa balcooa & Bambusa polymorpha* in South Tripura (01 model plantation) and West Tripura (02 model plantations) and their management practices.
