

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS

Bids shall be submitted online only at CPPP website: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>. Tenderers/Bidders are advised to follow the instructions provided in the "Instructions to the Tenderer/Bidder for the e-submission of the bids online through the Central Public Procurement Portal for e-Procurement at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer/bidder. Under no circumstances, the father and his sons(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. **A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.**

Tenderer/bidder who has downloaded the tender from the <http://www.icfre.gov.in> and Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>, **shall not temper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner.** In case, if the same is found to be tempered/modified in any manner, tender will be summarily rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer/bidder will be liable to be banned from doing business with ICFRE in future.

Intending tenderers/bidders are advised to visit again the ICFRE website <http://www.icfre.gov.in> and CPPP website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> at least 3 days prior to the closing date of submission of tender for any corrigendum / addendum / amendment etc.

Bids will be opened as per date/time as mentioned in the **Tender Critical Date Sheet.**

1.0 Qualifying Bid

Qualifying documents should be uploaded in CPPP Website <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>. The following documents are to be furnished by the Tenderer/Bidder, as qualifying bid, as signed alongwith the seal/stamp and scanned copy of original documents in *pdf* format uploaded in CPP Portal:

- (a) Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) should be made in the Form of FDR/Bank Guarantee/ Demand Draft from any Nationalized Bank in *favour of Director General, ICFRE, Dehradun* payable at Dehradun and scanned copy of the same should be uploaded in the CPP Portal, the hard copy of EMD should be sent to ADG (Admin), ICFRE Dehradun-248006 on or before the last date/time of qualifying bid submission.
- (b) A signed and scanned copy of affidavit in non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/- by the firm that it has never been blacklisted/debarred/banned by ICFRE or its Institutes/any Govt. department/Public Sector must be attached alongwith the bid failing which the bid shall be rejected.
- (c) Signed and scanned copy of original documents/certificates, GST, TIN No., and PAN.
- (d) Tender fee: The tender form downloaded from the aforementioned websites must include Rs. 2000/- + 18% GST by crossed Demand Draft in favour of Director General, ICFRE, Dehradun payable at Dehradun. It is not refundable. The hard copy of the same must be received on or before last date/time of opening the qualifying bid Scanned copy of the same should be uploaded in the Portal.
- (e) Interested bidders should clearly indicate submission of explicit documentary evidence with respect to the following, in absence of which the proposal will be rejected summarily at pre-qualification stage itself :-
 - (i) Be a Registered Company Under DOT (Department of Telecommunication) (Registration certificate to be submitted) with five years of existence.
 - (ii) **Have annual turnover of Rupees Twenty crores and above in previous two financial years in telephone services.**
 - (iii) Vender must be able to provide VoIP/VAS Services, IP Phones and telephone based operator console on payment basis as and when required by FRI/ICFRE & its Institutes in future.

- (iv) Have the experience of providing EPABX on rental in last five years of at least two (2) exchanges of similar capacity.
- (v) Signed and scanned copy of original profile and details of tendering firm in the formats given in **Annexure- I (Form I, Form II and Form V)**
- (vi) Signed and scanned copy of original letter of acceptance of tender conditions in the format given in **Annexure - II**
- (vii) Copy of the latest Landline Telephone /Electricity bill showing address of the Head Office/Branch Office.
- (viii) Duly attested copy of having GST statement paid to the Govt. for the last one year.

Note:- Bidder is requested to arrange the above documents in sequence with proper numbering

General Information:

- (i) Tenders are invited from reputed Telecom Service Providers for providing Electronic Private Automatic Branch Exchange (EPABX).
- (ii) Bidders are advised to study the tender document carefully. Submission of bids shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the tender document with full understanding of its implications.
- (iii) Any clarifications from ICFRE or any change in requirement will be posted on website. Hence before submitting the bids, bidder must ensure that such clarifications/changes have been considered by them. ICFRE will not have any responsibility in case some omission is done by any bidder.
- (vi) ICFRE has the right to reject any or all tenders received without assigning any reason whatsoever.

2 Submission of tender

The tender should be submitted in two parts, viz.,

- a. TECHNICAL BID.**
- b. FINANCIAL BID.**

3.1 Pre Bid Presentation

A pre bid presentation at ICFRE, Dehradun will be arranged between the Committee under the Chairmanship of ADG (Admin) and the bidders for clarification/finalization of terms & conditions etc. of the contract. Bidders must take part in pre-bid presentation at scheduled date and time and shall submit the model and technical specifications of the mechanism/machine to be deployed.

3.2 Financial Bid

- (a) The following Financial Proposal/Commercial bid format is provided as BoQ xls along with this tender document at <https://eprocure.gov.in/epublish/app>. Bidders are advised to download the format of BoQ xls as it is and quote their offer/rates in the permitted column and upload the same in the commercial bid. **Bidder shall not tamper/modify downloaded price bid template in any manner.** In case, the same is found to be tempered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer would be liable to be banned from doing business with Indian Council of Forestry Research & Education, Dehradun in future.

- (b) Administrative Charge/Service Charge will be inclusive of all taxes, fees, levies, etc. and any revision in the statutory taxes, fees, etc will be the responsibility of the Bidder and the same may be filled in the BoQ xls.
- (c) **GST should be clearly mentioned in the online financial proposal. It will be paid as per govt. norms.**
- (d) In case of any discrepancy/difference in the amounts indicated in figures and words the amount mentioned in words will prevail and will be considered.

4. BID EVALUATION, WORK ORDER, PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE AND AGREEMENT:

The following procedure will be adopted in evaluating the bids and issue of work order etc: -

a. Opening of Technical Bid :-

The Technical Bid in respect of all bidders as received upto the specified time and date will be opened by the Bid Evaluation Committee constituted by ICFRE for the purpose. Documents submitted therein will be checked and evaluated later on. Incomplete documents or Non-submission of required documents shall lead to the rejection of bids and WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR FURTHER EVALUATION. The bidders may remain present, if they wish so at that time of opening the Technical bids.

The bidder must score at least 70 points out of 100 in the technical evaluation to be considered for financial evaluation

b. Opening of Financial Bid:-

The Financial Bid evaluation will be carried out for total technical score of 30. The Financial Bid of only those bidders who qualify in the technical evaluation shall be opened as per the schedule of Tender. The Financial Bids of qualified bidders shall be opened and evaluated by the Bid Evaluation Committee.

Financial bid shall be evaluated out of maximum marks of 30. The lowest bid shall be given maximum marks of 30 and others bidders shall be given marks in inverse proportion to the bid amount.

The Financial bid evaluation will be carried out for a total technical score of 30. The Financial Bid of only those bidders who qualify in the technical evaluation shall be opened as per the Schedule of Tender. The Financial Bid of qualified bidders shall be opened and evaluated by the Bid Evaluation Committee.

Financial bid shall be evaluated out of maximum marks of 30. The lowest bid shall be given maximum marks of 30 and others bidders shall be given marks in inverse proportion to the bid amount.

- c. **Finalization of tender:** The bidder scoring highest by summing up marks obtained in both technical bid and financial bid shall be given the final work order. Depending on the total score (both technical and financial score), the work order will be given for providing – rental EPABX system for FRI/ICFRE and its institutes to the lowest quoted value.
- d. **The Work Order, Performance Bank Guarantee and Agreement:** Successful bidder shall be issued the Work Order giving 15 days' time to sign the Agreement with the Assistant Director General (Administration), ICFRE and start providing services as per the Agreement. The successful bidder shall furnish, before signing the Agreement, a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) issued by *a Nationalized Bank in favour of Director General, ICFRE, Dehradun*, having validity of minimum six months beyond the date of expiry of the Contract, for an amount equivalent to 15% of the total annual contract value. In case the successful bidder fails to provide the Performance Bank Guarantee, sign the agreement within 15 days and start providing the services as per the Agreement, the EMD of the bidder shall be forfeited and the tender will then be awarded to another party. The losses, if any, suffered in this regard will be payable by the defaulting party.

5. **EVALUATION OF PROPOSALS**

A three-stage evaluation procedure will be adopted.

(i) **Stage – 1 EVALUATION OF TECHNICAL PROPOSAL**

Qualifying/technical documents submitted along with the bid shall be checked, and disqualification amongst these documents will lead to rejection of the proposal.

The technical evaluation criteria will include the firms **relevant experience, technical manpower (qualifications, availability and experience) and availability of necessary infrastructure machinery etc.** The technical evaluation also includes examination of the quality of samples submitted with the proposal. Evaluation will be carried out for total technical score (St) of 100 and scoring 70 points out of 100 will be the eligible criteria for financial evaluation.

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(ii) **Stage - 2 EVALUATION OF FINANCIAL PROPOSAL**

$$S_f = 30 \times \frac{S_{\text{lowest}}}{S_b}$$

S_{lowest} = lowest bid amount

S_b = Amount of bid quoted by bidder 'b'

S_t = Technical bid score

Total marks = $S_f + S_t$

(iii) **Stage - 3 FINAL EVALUATION OF THE BID**

Proposal will finally be ranked according to their combined technical (S_t) and financial (S_f) scores using the weights $S = S_t \times T\% + S_f \times F\%$.

The weight (T%) given to the Technical Proposal is 70%

The weight (F%) given to the Financial Proposal is 30%

iv) **Financial Evaluation**

- a) The evaluation committee will determine if the financial proposals are complete and without computational errors.
 - b) The total cost of the proposal shall be the total cost computed based on the quoted rates.
 - c) The lowest financial proposals (L1) will be acceptable.
- v) Final evaluation criteria shall be taking into consideration the Technical & Financial points.

6. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES:

- 6.1
- a) The vendor shall start the project work within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of signing of contract agreement and the total contract period shall be of 05 (five) years from the date of signing of contract agreement and may be extended on mutual constant.
 - b) Vendor will provide on-site maintenance contract of the equipments in use and alternate services within 24 Hrs. in case of malfunctioning or failure of the equipment at FRI/ICFRE & its Institutes.
 - c) Vender must be able to provide VoIP/VAS Services, IP Phones and telephone based operator console on payment basis as and when required by FRI/ICFRE & its Institutes in future.

Infrastructure at FRI/ICFRE premises & its Institute shall be provide at its premises a 230 V Single Phase 50 Hz. point for equipment by the costumer.

6.2 New State of Art rental EPABX System along with (02) two Nos. PRI (rent free)

- a. Provision of complete switching installation, commissioning and testing equipment for
 - 700 working extensions.
 - Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) & Value Added Service (VAS) can be added through addition / replacement of cards at any time or should be compatible if required by the customer on payment basis in future.
- b. Provision of complete power plant including Batteries for 12-18 hours backup.
- c. Provision of complete MDF with line protection alongwith its wiring and testing.
- d. Provision of fault location, subscriber management and Billing Software etc.
- e. Provision of connecting it to the outside via PRI connectivity.
- f. Provision to deploy a Nodal Officer from the firm to coordinate amongst the exchange of the all location.
- g. The EPABX should support back bone as Fiber Optic between the buildings and internal wiring of copper.
- h) The vendor providing the EPABX shall use the existing cabling laid down for EPABX. The bidders are advised to inspect the existing infrastructure in their own interest before submitting the bids.

7 SPECIFIC TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- i) The tender for providing EPABX on Rental at FRI/ICFRE & its Institutes will have to be submitted in three parts viz. Pre bid presentation, Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal.
- ii) Acceptance of the bid shall be communicated to the successful bidder by a formal letter of intent.
- iii) The successful bidder will have to provide performance warranty equal to 5% of the contract value in the form of Demand Draft, FDR or Bank Guarantee in the name of Director General, ICFRE, Dehradun valid and renewable up to forty eight months from the date of signing of the agreement. This must be submitted within 10 days from award of contract.
- iv) The successful bidder shall be required to sign a Contract Agreement on a stamp paper of Rs. 100/- to be furnished by him within 15 days from award of contract.
- v) In case of discrepancy in the quoted prices (in figures and in words) the price written in words will be taken as valid.
- vi) Bidders must have their own infrastructure,
- vii) Short-listing of bidders does not confer any rights on any bidder, it only means that the offer made is under consideration.
- viii) While submitting the bid, the bidder shall be deemed to have read, understood and accepted all the terms and conditions stated in the Tender Document.
- ix) The bidder shall indicate the complete address of the Company/Office and work along with the name(s) of the contact person(s) and their telephone/fax/mobile nos.(s)/email addresses and other particulars as per Forms 3.
- x) The Financial proposal submitted by the bidder shall include all duties, taxes, octroi and overhead expenses, etc. applicable as per the rules of the land and the rates shall not be amended during the tenure of the contract.
- xi) The offer is for initially five years and may further be extended on mutual consent based on performance and as per existing rules.
- xii) The offer shall be valid for at least one month from the date of opening of the tender.
- xiii) Conditional tenders shall be rejected.
- xiv) In case of any dispute, the Director General, ICFRE shall decide the issue and his decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- xv) Part tender for providing service shall not be accepted.

8. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- i) During the term of engagement, the vendor project team shall devote the whole of their time and attention to the performance of the services and shall at all times act with due diligence and efficiency and in accordance with the Terms of Reference. The vendor's project team shall make or assist in making all such reports and recommendations as may be contemplated by the Terms of Reference or as may be reasonably required by the Client within the general scope of the Project, and shall at times cooperate with the Client, its employees and agents in the interest of the Project. Even after the termination of the engagement, the vendor shall continue to cooperate with the client to such reasonable extent as may be necessary to clarify or explain any reports or recommendations made by him/her.

- ii) At all times the vendor shall act with propriety and discretion and in particular shall refrain from making any public statement concerning the Project or the Services without the prior approval of the Client and shall refrain from engaging in any political activity.
- iii) Except with the written consent of the Client, he/she will not divulge to any person or use for own purpose any information relating to the services, the project or the client including information in respect of payments.
- iv) The vendor shall report immediately to the client any accident or injury and any damage to the property of the client or to the property or person of any third parties occurring in or arising out of the performance of the services and any act, matter or thing which within his/her knowledge may have caused such accident or injury. He/she shall also report immediately to the client any circumstances or events which might reasonably be expected to hinder or prejudice the performance or the services, including circumstances and events relating to his transportation and accommodation.
- v) All reports, notes, drawings, specifications, statistics, plans and other documents and data compiled or made by the vendor while performing the services shall be the property of the client and upon termination of the engagement shall be disposed off as the client shall direct. The vendor may retain copies of such documents.
- vi) After the conclusion of the Term of Engagement, the vendor shall not, without the consent of the client engage in subsequent work on or in connection with the project or arising out of the project provided. however, that such consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- vii) No legal proceedings to enforce any claim and no suit arising out of this contract shall be instituted except in a court of competent jurisdiction over Dehradun, Uttarakhand.
- viii) Commencement of Assignment shall be within 10 days from the date of acceptance of offer.
- xi) The Asstt. Director General (Admin.) ICFRE, Dehradun reserves the right without assigning any reasons thereof; to:
 - a) Accept or reject whole or any part of an offer
 - b) Reject any or all offers partly or wholly,
 - c) Cancel or withdraw the Tender notice
 - d) Accept or reject any deviations from these conditions

N.B : The Asstt. Director General (Admin) ICFRE, Dehradun is not bound to accept the lowest Tender or lowest part of any Tender.

9. PAYMENT TERMS:

- a) The payment shall be made as per review of the progress of work and output in phased manner as follows:

- b) No claim on account of GST, work contract tax or any other taxes and duties presently in force for the services/ material used for execution of the work awarded under the contract, will be entertained and all such taxes and duties shall be borne by the vendor himself.

Note : GST is to be included with the monthly bill of Rental EPABX

- c) The ICFRE shall deduct such taxes, duties and any other statutory levies imposed by the Government on such charges as may arise from the implementation of the contract agreement.
- d) The payment is subject to TDS as per Income tax rules/ laws.

10. PENALTIES:

a) Delay in Implementation

In case of delay in commissioning of EPABX by vendor, beyond 1 (One) month, for reason not attributable to ICFRE the ICFRE shall impose a penalty on vendor from the final payment @ 0.5% per week, subject to a maximum of 5% of the total project cost.

b) Penalty- Clause for EPABX

If the vendor fails to repair any equipment within 12 hours. they shall be warned and if fault continues to remain for more than 24 hours the vendor shall be penalized and rate of penalty shall be as given below:

11. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

11.1 Roles and Responsibilities of ICFRE

- a. Provision of adequate free space and earthings.
- b. Provision of free power and air conditioned environment
- c. Provision of internal wiring from the MDF at the Switch Room to the subscriber points.
- d. Provision of Telephone Instruments.

11.2 Roles and Responsibilities of the vender

New State of Art rental EPABX system along with (02) two Nos. PRI (rent free)

- a. Provision of complete switching installation, commissioning and testing equipment for
 - 700 working extensions.
 - Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) & Value Added Service (VAS) can be added through addition / replacement of cards at any time or should be compatible if required by the customer on payment basis in future.
- b. Provision of complete power plant including Batteries for 12-18 hours backup.
- c. Provision of complete MDF with line protection alongwith its wiring and testing.
- d. Provision of fault location, subscriber management and Billing Software etc.
- e. Provision of connecting it to the outside via PRI connectivity in ratio of 1:12.
- f. Provision to deploy a Nodal Officer from the firm to coordinate amongst the exchange of the all locations.

- g. Vender must be able to provide VoIP/VAS Services, IP Phones and telephone based operator console on payment basis as and when required by FRI/ICFRE & its Institutes in future.

Note:

Basic need and specifications of rental EPABX of all Institutes except FRI/ICFRE may be obtained from the concerned Institute/Centre by the vendor as per standard EPABX system, rent free PRI lines, complete MDF etc. before quoting the rate.

12. TIMELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION WITH DELIVERABLES:

- 12.1 Unless extended by Mutual consent of the parties, the project shall be completed within a period of 1(one) month from the date of signing of the Agreement.
- 12.2 The vendor shall submit a detailed plan (activity wise time line) for carrying out the work within contract period. The vendor shall submit a progress report on weekly basis to the Member Secretary.
- 12.3 The vendor's representatives shall contact with Technical Committee and explain the progress made and also facilitate the deliverables by the technical committee.
- 12.4 The date of satisfactory completion of services shall be the date on which ICFRE accepts by issuing an appropriate certificate of satisfactory completion of services by the Technical Committee.

13. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 13.1 **Informal dispute resolution :** The parties agree to attempt to resolve all disputes arising under the Agreement through negotiation, in good faith and using their best endeavours. To this end, the parties agree to provide frank, candid and timely disclosure of all relevant facts, information and documents to facilitate discussions between them/their representatives or senior officers.
- 13.2 **Arbitration:** Except where otherwise provided in the contract all questions and disputes whatsoever in any way arising out of or relation to the contract or otherwise concerning the work or the execution or failure to execute the same whether arising during the progress of the consultancy or after the completion or abandonment therefore shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the person appointed by the Director General, Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education, Dehradun on his behalf at the time of dispute. There will be no objection to any such appointment that the arbitrator so appointed is an employee of ICFRE, or government servant or that he had to deal with the matters to which the contract relates or that in the course of his duties as employee of ICFRE, or government servant, he had expressed views on all or any of the matters in dispute or differences. The arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred, or being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason shall be replaced by another person as decided by Director General, ICFRE, to act as arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the contract. Such person shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor. It is also a term of this contract that no person other than a person appointed by the Director General, ICFRE should act as arbitrator and if for any reason, that is not possible, the matter is not to be referred to arbitration at all. In all cases where the amount of the claim in dispute is Rs. 50,000/- and above, the arbitrator shall give reasons for the award.

Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996, not any statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof and the rules made there

under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause.

Services under the contract shall, notwithstanding the existence of any such dispute, question or controversy continue during arbitration proceedings and no payment due or payable by ICFRE or the Firm shall be withheld on account of such proceedings unless such payments are the direct subject of the arbitration. Reference to arbitration shall be a condition precedent to any other action at law.

13.3 This Clause will survive the termination or expiry of this agreement.

14 FORCE MAJEURE:

14.1 The performance of the obligations of either party under this agreement is subject to *force majeure*.

14.2 If a *force majeure* situation arises, either party shall promptly notify to the other party in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless directed by ICFRE in writing, the vendor shall continue to perform its obligations under this agreement, as far as it is reasonably practical. Either party reserves the right to terminate this contract, without any additional liabilities to either party, if the *force majeure* period continues for more than 90 (ninety days).
